Are you feeling overwhelmed?

In times of uncertainty, it's normal to feel angry, sad and scared. Sometimes, these feelings can be very intense, affecting our mental and physical wellbeing.

Symptoms of anxiety can include:

- feeling fearful
- ♦ shaking
- short, shallow breathing, difficulty breathing or swallowing
- heart beating fast
- chest pains
- worrying thoughts
- inability to concentrate
- trouble relaxing
- unable to make decisions
- ♦ confusion

Symptoms of depression can include:

- extreme sadness and crying a lot, even though nothing terrible has happened
- feeling unhappy most of the time
- withdrawing from family and friends
- not wanting to engage in activities that you previously enjoyed
- lack of motivation and enthusiasm
- unable to make decisions
- unable to concentrate
- tiredness
- inability to sleep or sleeping too much
- feeling helpless or hopeless

Symptoms can be mild to severe. Anxiety or depression is usually diagnosed when someone experiences a number of the above symptoms for two weeks or more. It's important to recognise when you're not coping and to seek help when you need it. If you're concerned about your mental health, see your GP, as only doctors can diagnose anxiety or depression.

Talking to family members or friends can be helpful. If you need additional help, a professional counsellor or psychologist can help you learn some coping techniques and strategies. There are also a number of organisations who can give free online or telephone support. Some of these are listed below.
