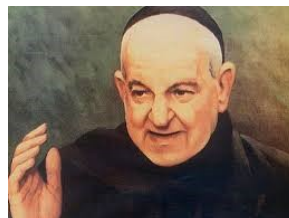
The Bargain Centre will be opened

WHAT IS INVOLVED IN THE DIACONATE

In Acts of the Apostles (6:1-6) the apostles established the Order of Deacons. The Order of Deacon is understood as follows:

A man who is ordained as a deacon received the sacrament of Holy Orders by the Bishop who places his hands on the head of the one being ordained and prays that God will give him the special gifts of the Holy Spirit needed to carry out his ministry. However deacons are not priests.

The word deacon derives from the Greek *diakonia* meaning “service”, thereby indicating that a deacon is called like Christ to be a servant. The Order of Deacon has three essential functions: The proclamation of the Gospel, the service of the liturgy and the administration of pastoral care and charity.

A deacon may baptise, preach, officiate at marriages and funerals, bring viaticum to the dying but cannot preside at Eucharist, give absolution or administer the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick or administer the Sacrament of Confirmation. Before someone is ordained a priest, he is first ordained to the order of deacon. The diaconate is a time of transition towards ordination to the priesthood.

The work of the Deacon has been described as being commissioned by the bishop to discern the needs of people, and bringing back word of needs to the diocesan and/or parish community.

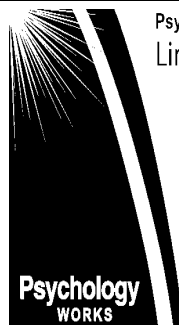
