

The Jesse Tree

Each week during Advent we will think about the Jesse Tree and it's place in our Advent preparation

It would be impossible to look at every single thing that God did for his people before Jesus was born, but maybe we can look at a few of those things over the next four weeks. We will decorate Jesus' family tree. This tree is called '**The Jesse Tree**'. This is the name given to the promises that God made throughout the Old Testament concerning the birth of His only Son.

Just like our Christmas tree, '**The Jesse Tree**' has beautiful decorations, but instead of having stars and lights on it, it has the promises that God made to us and to His people, promises made out of love.

The tree is named after Jesse, the father of David, the great king of Israel. The reason for this is that some of the most important promises of all were made to Jesse and to his son David. They were promised that God's only Son would be born in their family.

We will now hear about some of the people who waited for Jesus' birth.

1. Adam:

I am Adam. This is my wife Eve. We are the first man and woman. It is to us that God made His promise to send Jesus. **Our symbol is an apple.**

2. Noah:

I am Noah. God chose and saved me, my family and many animals from the flood. **My symbol is the ark.**

3. Abraham:

I am Abraham. God chose me to be the father of his special people. Because I trusted God when He asked me to sacrifice my son, Isaac, God blessed me with many children, who waited for the coming of Jesus. **My symbol is pile of burning branches.**


