While we give the needy physical food, assistance with electricity costs and vouchers for supermarkets we find that often the vouchers have to get used up on things like soap, toothpaste, deodorant and other personal hygiene material etc. Obviously this greatly depletes the value of vouchers for food.

So can you please place items in the boxes at the back of the churches over the next few weeks. No particular packaging is required and the environment will be happier without more plastic bags.

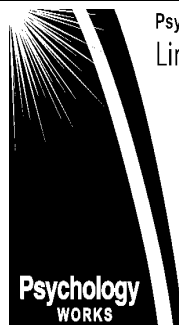
