St George Preca was born on the 12 February 1880 in Valletta, Malta. St George was dedicated to the service of lay people. After his ordination, he began teaching along the waterfront, working with the roughest of men. He gathered a group of young male catechists, including the Servant of God Ewgenju Borg, and they formed the beginning of the Society of Christian Doctrine at Hamrun, Malta in 1907. The Society's motto is represented by the letters M.U.S.E.U.M. (Magister Utinam Sequator Evangelium Universus Mundus). This translates to "Divine Teacher may the whole world follow the Gospel". St George and his faithful followers were dedicated to bringing the Bible and theology to lay people and the working classes.




### <u>Pentecost Multicultural Mass and Dinner</u> <u>Vigil Mass - Saturday 8th June</u>
