Notice Regarding Mass in Our Parish

Religious gatherings are permitted with gatherings of up to 10 people.

Mass will resume in our parish from Saturday 23rd May, with the following guidelines:

1. A maximum of 10 people will be allowed to attend each Mass.
2. **Parishioners will need to contact the parish office to pre-register to attend Saturday Vigil and Sunday Masses.** Please note that only those who have registered will be permitted to attend the Mass. Parishioners cannot just “turn up”.
3. In order to give everyone an opportunity to attend Mass, we can only allow each person to register to attend one Mass, until everyone who wants to attend has had a turn.
4. Please be mindful of social distancing at all times. We will have marked places in the pews for people to sit, and these must be adhered to. A maximum of 2 people will be permitted to sit in a pew.
5. Hand sanitizer will be available at the church entrance. Please use upon entry and exit.

Parishioners are reminded of the following:

1. Catholics in the Diocese of Parramatta are dispensed from their Sunday obligations until further notice.
2. People over 60 years of age with pre-existing conditions and those who are over 70 are regarded as being vulnerable, and should be prudent in venturing out.
3. If you are unwell, or live with someone who is unwell, please do not visit the church until you have been cleared by a registered practitioner.
