

#### MIGRANT AND REFUGEE SUNDAY

As we celebrate the 106th World Day of Migrants and Refugees amidst a pandemic sweeping across the world with the theme chosen by our Holy Father Pope Francis, "Forced like Jesus Christ to flee," we must pray to the Holy Spirit, to enlighten our individual and national conscience. To renew our hearts with the love of God and through this a genuine love for all human beings. To assist in this I wish to place a few questions for your reflection: Are we pastorally sensitive to the needs of migrants in our community? Do we speak with a prophetic voice, on behalf of the needs and the rights of migrants, especially for those refugees and persons seeking asylum on discriminatory grounds, which is an integral part of our Christian baptismal vocation? Have we properly engaged in an interfaith dialogue with migrants who come from different faith backgrounds so that they might more clearly see and understand the light of Christ, in both our words and deeds? May we see the face of Christ in all our brothers and sisters who are "Forced like Jesus Christ to flee "
