Diocesan Synod 2023

Inspired by the Holy Spirit, the Diocese of Parramatta seeks to engage in a process of listening, dialogue and discernment to learn and understand the path to becoming a more synodal church. To be synodal means to “walk together” guided by the Holy Spirit.

The fundamental question that will guide the journey towards the Synod is:

In what ways can we respond to the call of the Holy Spirit to be a more synodal Church in the Diocese of Parramatta?

To assist participants to explore the fundamental question, the following questions aim to provide a framework for discussion on one-on-one or group setting:

Communion:

1. What are the factors that make a great community? What brings people together?
2. How can the church in Western Sydney and the Blue Mountains deepen communion, and still honour the rich diversity of our community?
3. How do you try to accompany or “walk with” family and friends through their struggles and joys?

We will be having a meeting at Holy Family Church on Thursday 15th June at 7pm. All parishioners are invited to attend.
